



Supplier statement on the use of so-called “Conflict Minerals”

HARTING intends to work with suppliers who source their raw materials, semi-finished products and trade goods in an ethical manner. Companies that source materials as tin, tungsten, tantalum or gold will also be required to make this information publicly available. Therefore we ask you read carefully the following declaration and stamp, sign and return in case of your agreement:

Herewith we declare as follows:

- We have a policy which ensures that our sub-suppliers do not purchase raw materials as tin, tungsten, tantalum or gold from conflict zones, including the Democratic Republic of Congo or any adjoining country and/or from regions where serious ethical and/or environmental concerns have been legitimately raised (“Conflict Minerals”).
- Herewith, we confirm that we have not, and will not, supply HARTING with products that contain Conflict Minerals or raw materials, semi-finished products and trade goods sourced from regions where serious ethical and/or environmental concerns have been legitimately raised.
